We must do all that we can to get our signatures and all of the signatures of every voter in Maryland onto the referendum forms that are circulating at every parish in the state that call for a vote against the same sex marriage bill that was passed by our Governor and State. Not only are Catholics up in arms but all of the organized religions in the state are equally up in arms to vote this bill down. What can you do beside signing the form? You can call your parish office and volunteer your services as a Knight of Columbus to help run the signing campaign or take it on yourself if nobody is already starting the campaign. The MD Catholic Conference has all of the literature, forms, and training necessary to have one of these voter signings. I have this information as well and am trying to make sure that all of the parishes around us in the district are being represented and helped by the Knights. I also was trained by Mary Ellen Russell of the MCC at the State Spring meeting on March 30th. The process for this voter signing is not difficult, you must however follow some simple guidelines such as signing the form with your exact name as it is indicated on your voter registration card. Not sure what your card said or lost your card? You can go to www.mdelections.com and check it out. If you do not have access to a computer, then call me or there may be a computer at the sign up site that you may check. But don't wait until it is too late, check your name first and then sign the referendum form as quickly as possible. We must sign up 56,000 voters on this first go around before May 31st so that this will be placed on the ballot in November. Then in November please remember to vote down this same sex marriage bill. We will have more information and reminders as the time comes closer toward November.

Do you have coverage?
